Literacy is the most important tool to ensure a child's success. Yet, in California, only 1 in 3 fourth graders can read proficiently and 88% of fourth graders from low-income families are reading below grade level.

## Making A Difference

God has given us opportunities through the years to touch the lives of the homeless, the inner-city, the working poor, the imprisoned, those serving our country, and those in need of just a little help getting through rough patches in life.

This holiday season Baysider's provided 1,052 gifts to children who have a parent in prison, 217 gifts to children that have a parent in Teen Challenge, collected 5,200 pounds of food for Placer Food Bank, provided 8,140 pairs of shoes to third world countries, gave more than 250 gifts to children at the North Roseville R.E.C. Center, collected 300 toys for children who's parent is serving in the military, provided 140 gifts cards to children in the foster care system, provided food and gifts to 360 families in the Adopt A Family program, volunteered for more than 1,000 hours ringing the bell at the Salvation Army Red Kettle stations in South Placer, sent 178 care packages to military personnel serving overseas and provided more 500 toys to the Secret Santa Store.

**TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM Plus**

In Sacramento County, approximately 387 foster youth will 'age out' of the foster care system this year. At age 18, they're considered adults and no longer eligible for support. These teenagers, who comprise more than half of those in foster care, will leave the system alone, without family or other positive role models to help them as they transition into adulthood.

Studies show that 40% will suffer serious physical victimization, including sexual assault. Thirty percent will be homeless and 33% will be forced to rely on public assistance.
