### The 10 Commandments

1. Do not ask a person out that you don't already have a relationship with. This ministry isn't a marriage market.
2. Do not presume someone is hitting on you when they're just being nice. Recognize that people are friendly here.
3. Practice personal boundaries. Just say no; don't say yes when you really mean no. Be polite, yet honest.
4. Do not gossip. Don't say things to divide people. Instead, encourage and build each other up.
5. One may not date until his/her divorce is legal and final. Dating someone while a divorce is pending is considered adultery.
6. One should not participate in the Singles' Ministry until his/her divorce is legal and final. Exceptions may be made. To request an exception, discuss the matter personally with the Singles' Pastor, Michael Baggett.
7. Honor the privacy of others. Personal information may not be used for any reason without permission.
8. This is an alcohol-free environment. Don't bring alcohol to any Bayside Singles' Ministry events or functions. If you choose to drink before an event, don't attend if you can't drive legally.
9. Bayside Singles' Ministry does not promote personal events. All promoted events are held and sponsored by the Singles' Ministry.
10. Do not give advice, dominate the conversation or interrupt others in table discussion. Use your table manners. Listen and share appropriately. You do, however, have the right to remain silent.
