3. Have you ever taken matters into your own hands hoping to do something good for the Lord? How did that go for you? How did God fix the problem?

### **INTERPRET THE PASSAGE**

4. Read John 18:1-26. How does Jesus identify Himself? Why would His response escalate tension and hostility as His enemies sought to arrest and kill Him?
5. Read John 18:27-40. Why was Jesus willing to be obedient and "drink the cup" His Father had given Him?

### **TAKE THIS PASSAGE INTO YOUR LIFE**

6. There is a bit of Peter in all of us! What fears do you have about being fully identified with Jesus Christ?
7. How is Jesus our example of how to respond when friends abandon us or we are falsely accused or when asked to do something difficult out of obedience to God?

### **HEAR FROM GOD**

8. How is God speaking to you through this passage and sermon? Take some time and thank Him for the new ways He is revealing truth to you.
