When is the trip?

March 31st – April 7th *To participate on this trip, you must be able to depart and return with the group. If you cannot be with us for the entirety of the trip, then this is not the year for you to go. There will be no exceptions.

What is the cost?

- HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS
 - \$799 Early Bird before November 30th
 - **\$849** after November 30th
 - Both options include the \$149 application fee due on registration
- COLLEGE STUDENTS (HS GRAD-24YRS OLD)
 - \$699 Early Bird before November 30th
 - **\$749** after November 30th
 - Both options include the \$149 application fee due on registration
- o ADULTS (25YRS & OLDER)
 - \$399 Early Bird before November 30th
 - **\$449** after November 30th
 - Both options include the \$149 application fee due on registration

When do medications need to be turned in?

High School students must turn in ALL of their medication to the First-Aid Team during commissioning services. This includes Over-the-Counter medications. Students are not to have any medications in their possession during the entirety of the trip, save for students who require an Inhaler, Insulin, Epi-pen or have prior special approval from the First-Aid Team. In most cases the medications will be handed out during "Medication Hours" in the morning and the evening. This is for the safety of all students.

What if I don't have a US Passport?

If your passport has been issued by a country other than the United States of America, it is YOUR responsibility to call your Consulate to make sure you have the proper documentation for travel outside the USA, as well as for re-entry into the USA.

Can I be dropped off late/separate from the group?

Individuals CANNOT be dropped off late or separately; or picked up early or separately from this trip. If you cannot be with us for the entirety of the trip, then this is not the year for you to go. No exceptions.

What if I can't afford the cost?

While we do offer partial scholarships, we ask that you also raise your own support for Mexico 2023. Many students have paid their entire trip cost through their own fundraising.

Can I receive a refund?

Refunds are available until January 31, 2023, less the \$149 non-refundable registration fee. Unfortunately, we do not offer refunds after February 1, 2023.
