WHY MEXICO?

Bayside has been crossing the border and God has been transforming lives for 27 years. During Easter week, students and adults come together to serve as the hands and feet of Jesus across the Mexicali valley. Our church started this trip in 1996 with a group of 26 and has grown to over 1000+ because of the positive and lasting impact on the Mexican community and on the Americans that go.

The large group divides into smaller teams that serve our partner churches and organizations. An average alfalfa field in a rural farming town is turned into a small city of green army tents. We begin each day with time in God's word, worship, and prayer before going out to our various ministry locations. After a full day of serving our hearts out, we return to camp for good food, worship under the stars, and a powerful Biblical message.

Now, more than ever, our simple act of showing up will bring encouragement and support to our brothers and sisters in Mexico. We learn so much from them as we see how they advance the Gospel in their communities with limited means, and we serve alongside them to shine the light and love of Christ!

IMPACT



Bayside's Breakaway Kids Camp goes to Mexico! This team partners with the local churches to minister to the kids in the community sharing the Gospel message. Key components to impact teams are games, Bible stories, arts and crafts, worship and giving lots of piggyback rides.

CONSTRUCTION

FUNDRAISE YEAR-ROUND

Interpreting for Mexico Outreach with Bayside Church

First of all, thank you for volunteering or thinking about being part of this mission trip. The interpreter role is a very important duty on this trip. We could not do this without you. You will be translating conversations between the adult leaders, students, children and pastors. In a way, the interpreter can be seen as a leadership role with the interpreter and the adult leader working together to keep the communication flowing.

WHAT TO EXPECT

You will be assigned to a specific team and you will travel and serve with them. We will have English/Spanish Bibles available so there will be no need to interpret when Bible reading is taking place. We will sometimes be translating in front of the congregations but will mostly be translating between the team and Mexican children. Translating for prayers is not required since God understands Spanish and English but is optional depending on the situation and what feels comfortable. Please note, if you are over 25 with a valid driver's license, we will need you to drive. Additionally, there will be one evening that the pastors are invited to base camp and we ask that you stay with your assigned pastor for that evening. We will need all interpreters available that night for welcoming our guests and to help direct people to where they need to go. Lastly, we will have meetings right after the leader meeting every morning.

COST:

It's on us. Bayside pays for your trip as a show of appreciation for coming on this mission's trip. Email Mexicooutreach@baysideonline.com to ask questions and receive further steps on how to register.

WHAT TO BRING

Cot, sleeping bag, snacks, clothes for the week, valid passport or green card, and the money for food while traveling to/from Mexico (all other food will be provided). For a full packing list, see Mexico Outreach website.

FLEXI-CALI

We like to call our Mexico Outreach trip to Mexicali "Flexi-cali" because sometimes things don't always go according to the plan and we need you to be patient and flexible with the schedules and with other volunteers. Know that all changes are made with the best of intentions. If you have any specific questions or need more information, please don't hesitate to contact us.

LEADERSHIP

Leaders have made a personal decision to follow Jesus, attend Bayside Church, and participate in Bayside's ministries.

Team Leader C A

Each Team Leader has had significant experience with Bayside Mexico Outreach and Student Ministries at Bayside, and has proven themselves in their ability to communicate clearly, maintain a positive attitude, carry themselves with maturity, build healthy relationships and execute the plans and directives of Bayside. Team Leaders are responsible for providing oversight at ministry sites and holding teens to safety measures they agreed to during training. Team Leaders should complete Bayside's Growth Track by March 2023, be a Bayside Church member and an active participant in a Bayside group.

Assistant Leader C A

Assistant Leaders provide leadership support to the team leaders. Assistant Adult Leaders must also have proven themselves in their ability to communicate clearly, maintain positive attitude, carry themselves with maturity, build healthy relationships and execute on the plans and directives of Bayside.

Student Leader HS C

Student Leaders are responsible for casting vision to the team and directing ministry on a daily basis. They should develop their teams spiritually and hold them accountable to growth opportunities. They are expected to help their peers process through their trip as it progresses. Student Leaders should be confident and ready to vocally direct a large group of students in the right direction. Student Leaders are accountable to student ministry pastors, staff and Team Leader.
