Faith Alive Foundation's vision is to be a self-sustaining, internationally recognized medical and social services center which meets the needs of humanity in a holistic way. Faith Alive exists to serve humanity by expressing God's love through compassionate voluntary services and the provision of free holistic healthcare and social services for an improved quality of life.

The ministry has become a full-scale hospital and social services center that offers free medical services ranging from HIV Testing Services to specialized care in surgery. With slightly more than 200 staff and volunteers, about 1.5M persons benefit annually including a free preschool and elementary school and 8 satellite clinics and social services center nation-wide.

Coming in 2026 is a brand-new, free, high-quality pediatric hospital, funded and built by Bayside Church.



The Morgans help lead a hybrid program that welcomes 7th-12th grade students to join them for one week each month. The goal of this program is to partner with parents to help students thrive spiritually, socially, and academically—while equipping them to remain and serve in places where there is a great need for kingdom workers.

Most of their time is devoted to caring for the families and students involved in this program. In addition, they help organize camps and retreats for other global worker families and their children and serve with youth in their local church.

At the heart of their ministry, the Morgans describe their role as cultivating rhythms and community. They create safe spaces where parents and students can invite Jesus into every part of their lives—especially the messy and hard parts. Through care, encouragement, and practical tools, they help families take steps forward in following Jesus as He meets them where they are and leads them into the life He has for them.

Cambodia & Belize

Agape International Missions is doing whatever it takes to end one of the greatest evils of our lifetime, human sextrafficking. They work to relentlessly rescue, heal and empower survivors of trafficking to be free. This work doesn't stop at rescue. For these girls to truly heal and grow, they need to feel the unconditional, relentless love of Christ. When this love is shown, survivors understand their true worth and value, and then they are able to become abolitionists themselves.

For almost 20 years, AIM has been working in Cambodia. The transformation they have seen in individuals, families, and communities is awe-inspiring and a testament to God's love and care for each of us! In all of our programs, AIM works to end trafficking through restoration homes, education, AIM SWAT team, training employment centers, community outreach, and discipleship. Bayside's support helped to launch the AIM SWAT Team where over 1.600 girls have been rescued and over 500 traffickers have been arrested.

China Missions Ministry

China

China Missions Ministry is a family of ministries, which share the same Christ-honoring purpose -- "make disciples in China and in the regions beyond." They have been partnering with Bayside since 2010.

Because persecution is at an all-time high, the ministry strategy has changed a bit. For most of the last 20 years, they have depended on large events to bring people to Christ and form home fellowships. However, because the large gatherings expose the ministry, their strategy has now shifted to growing the current home fellowships from within and when they reach a certain number of people in the fellowship they divide and start a new fellowship. A longer process but slowly becoming highly effective!

Because of the difficulty of getting both a passport and a visa to go to another country, God has, in His wisdom, opened up opportunities to go to the least reached within China.

Bayside has partnered with the Pagaragan family since 2010 when they first moved to Japan. Since 2017, Bayside has been sending teams to visit their ministry called The Neighborhood.



India Ministry

<u>India</u>

The India Ministry works to prevent human trafficking of children in the lowest castes of India. They believe that the solution involves the overall transformation of the culture and communities that accept child trafficking as a normal way of life. Bayside has been partnering with the India Ministry since 2003 and have sent several teams to visit the Bayside sponsored village of Bahman Baratta.

The India Ministry develops spiritual curriculum for children in sex trafficking villages and equips them to become leaders who break the cycle of bondage. They raise new missionaries to lead village projects, provide access to education for children through tutoring centers, share the gospel in the villages, and protect girls at risk through residential programs.

In July 2021, they opened their first Girl's Shelter Home welcoming 15 at-risk girls. They all attend a private school, have tutoring, daily devotions and do not have to experience being threatened daily to be sold into trafficking.



Each program has been developed by Indians, for Indians, and is designed to work effectively within specific physical, emotional, and social challenges such as poverty and caste discrimination.

JVI was born out of a calling to bring light into the darkest places. While practicing law in Washington, D.C., founder Jeff Pankratz took on a pro bono case fighting slavery in South Asia. What he witnessed—families trapped in bonded labor, women and children exploited in sex trafficking, and communities crushed by injustice—changed him forever.

Yet amid the injustice, Jeff also saw courageous local leaders faithfully serving on the frontlines with almost no resources. He realized that people from far away could join them in seeking justice for the poor and oppressed.

Today, JVI partners with these leaders to free those in bondage, restore survivors, and bring perpetrators to justice. The success of this network model is fueling growth: JVI is deepening its impact across South Asia and expanding into Africa. Together, with churches, partners, and people like you, we can bring freedom, justice, and restoration to millions more.

InterVarsity exists to reach every corner of campuses to send students to global mission fields and produce awardwinning books and video resources.

Matt and Rebekah started with InterVarsity in Southern California, before they moved to Bosnia and Herzegovina to continue their ministry. Rebekah grew up at Bayside, where her parents are still heavily involved. The Meyers have been Bayside partners since 2015.

The Bosnia Global Program involves a close partnership with the International Fellowship of Evangelical Students (IFES) movement in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The student live in the dorms and build relationships with Bosnian college students as part of a cultural exchange, learning how to communicate across cultures & learning how to share their faith with those in their life.

Young Life



Central & Eastern Europe

Al and Stacy Anderson serve with Young Life in Central and Eastern Europe with the vision of introducing young people to Jesus Christ and helping them grow in their faith. Young Life in Central and Eastern Europe is active in Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary, Romania, Bulgaria, Albania and North Macedonia. In the summer of 2022, Young Life put on 11 different camps for middle school and high school aged students. In 2023, they started a Ukrainian language ministry in 6 cities for teens displaced because of the war.

Their vision is to train and develop national leaders to share Jesus through friendships with teenagers. The Andersons work with national staff in each of these countries who run outreach camps and clubs, lead regular Bible Studies to help students grow in their faith and help young believers connect to a local church. Al, the Regional Director, has a focus on developing key national leaders and country directors and expanding ministry into new countries. Stacy, the Regional Trainer, develops and trains national staff in each country as they train and equip local volunteers.

3rd Person believes that poverty is primarily the result of broken relationships and systems and not just a lack of material resources. 3rd Person works with key nationals empowering them to inject hope in their communities and restore broken relationships and systems within them.

3rd Person fully supports TenThirtyThree (1033) in which they employ Syrian refugees in the Quesmay community to make handbags and accessories. This business teaches marketable skills and creates sustainable sources of income as well as adds a valuable asset to the community. Eden Football Club (EFC) is a football club for 200+ local refugee children in their community. EFC uses soccer to develop teamwork, competition, sportsmanship, self-worth and prevents drug abuse.

3rd Person also runs a kindergarten 6 days a week for refugee children that teaches English, Arabic, Math, Art, Biblical Values and provides glasses and dental care. EMPOWERING



4GENetwork





The 4GENetwork is dedicated and focused on training pastors and leaders around the world to become disciple makers and then to build disciple making churches through training their people to become disciples who make disciples who also make disciples. Their mission extends to five continents and influences about 100 countries in the world.

In 2022, the 4GENetwork has trained pastors in India, West Africa and Cuba. They also serve pastors across the USA and work alongside other ministries to provide a disciple making roadmap for churches and specific pathways and tools for training disciples who also make disciples. By year's end, they will have trained about 1500 pastors and leaders and their partners that they train will have trained about 10,000.

Samaritan's Purse

Operation Christmas Child is a project run by Samaritan's Purse, a Christian relief organization. Each year, people are encouraged to pack shoeboxes with small toys, school supplies, and hygiene items, which are then sent to children in need around the world. Along with the gifts, every box includes a booklet about Jesus, and are invited to join a Bible-based program called The Greatest Journey.

Supporters see the project as a way to spread kindness and share the message of Christianity with children living in difficult conditions. Since 1993, more than 232 million shoeboxes have been collected and delivered to children in over 170 countries. Over 24 million children have accepted Jesus Christ through this program — and many have gone on to share their faith with family and friends.




